FOREWORD

The year 1992 has been a period of growth, challenge and change for the University of Alberta's Department of Rural Economy. During 1992 faculty members participated in the consultations and debates that will lead, in 1993, to a major reorientation of all the undergraduate programs in the Faculty of Agriculture and Forestry. Rural Economy's graduate programs, in Agricultural Economics, Rural Sociology and Forest Economics, continued in 1992 to draw excellent students from across Canada and from many other nations. Some 40 students were registered in Rural Economy graduate programs in December 1992. The numbers of graduate students holding prestigious scholarships and similar awards increased during the year. The thesis of a recent M.Sc. graduate from the department, Peter Boxall, was recognized in 1992 by an Outstanding Master's Thesis Award by the Canadian Agricultural Economics and Farm Management Society. Research grants held by members of the Department also continued to increase in number and value. Challenges during the year included the necessity for faculty and support staff to handle increased responsibilities as budgetary pressures led to a decline in staff resources.

The Department commenced an international program with the Department of Agricultural Economics and Extension of the University of Zimbabwe and with IDRC. This project, on The Value of Trees, will foster research and the training of graduate students at both the University of Alberta and the University of Zimbabwe. Members of the Department also participated in an on-going University of Alberta project to strengthen institutions in Kenya, a continuing rural outreach program in Thailand, and a recent research project in India. Visiting scholars from China, Thailand, Cameroon and Nigeria were based in the Department for periods during the year.

Rural Economy was also fortunate to be able to welcome two new faculty members during 1992. Scott Jeffrey, previously a faculty member at the University of Manitoba, and a specialist in production economics, farm management and agribusiness management, joined the department in July 1992. Eloise Murray, a specialist on women in development and management training, who also holds a partial appointment in the Women's Studies Program returned from administrative leave in July 1992. Rural Economy had become her "home department" in the previous year.

A less happy change in staffing during the year arose from financial restructuring within the University. The consequent elimination in September of the administrative support position within Rural Economy meant the loss of an old friend and colleague. Reg Norby's years of support to undergraduate and graduate students in the Faculty of Agriculture and Forestry are being recognized by contributions from colleagues, friends, and the students of the Agriculture Club, toward capital improvements in the facilities of the 5th floor lounge of the Agriculture-Forestry Building.

With these changes, the Department of Rural Economy staff complement currently stands at 13 "full-time equivalent" University-funded academic positions and 6 support staff. Linkages through joint appointments of several faculty members and adjunct relationships with other departments from the University of Alberta, as well as other institutions, give students access to some 23 faculty members in total. Collaborating departments, faculties, and other institutions include the Departments of Economics and Forest Science and the Faculties of Arts (Women's Studies), Business and Extension, as well as Forestry Canada and the Canadian Wheat Board.

A major achievement of collaborative efforts by leaders in the agricultural industry in Alberta representing cooperatives and agricultural marketing institutions led in May 1992 to the signing, at University House, of an agreement between these donors, and the University of Alberta, to establish the Cooperative Chair in Agricultural Marketing and Business, to be based in Rural Economy. The Cooperative Chair Council instituted to guide this venture consists of 8 industry donors and 7 university representatives, chaired by Mr. Ed Schultz, General Manager of the Alberta Pork Producers' Development Corporation. The Council is guiding final fund raising efforts to achieve the 2 million dollars required to fund the Chair. Some funds remain to be raised, however it is expected that this position may be filled in 1994.

1992 was the second year during which Rural Economy was the recipient of the Alberta Agricultural Research Institute Professorship award in Marketing of Value-Added Agricultural and Food Products. This position is currently held by Jim Eales. Other greatly-appreciated donations to undergraduate and graduate education and to research in areas of specialization within Rural Economy were made by donors to the Jones Memorial Trust, the fund in memory of Graham and Ethel Jones, and to the Rural Economy Library fund, which contributes to the costs of book purchases for the Eric Berg Memorial Reading Room. Friends of Rural Economy will be aware that this Reading Room honours an early member of the department.

Temporary staff changes during the year included leaves for 12 months from June 30 1992, of Len Bauer and Bill Phillips. With this leave, Bill Phillips concluded a 5-year period of service to Rural Economy as Chairman of the Department from July 1987 to June 1992.

Activities in 1993 for Rural Economy will include the hosting of a combined meeting of the Western Agricultural Economics Association and the Canadian Agricultural Economics and Farm Management Society. We hope that this event, to be held July 11-14 at the University of Alberta, may also be the occasion for a reunion of the many former students, friends, and staff of this Department, since its inception in 1961, whether under its previous names of the Department of Agricultural Economics, Department of Agricultural Economics and Rural Sociology, or, as most recently, the Department of Rural Economy. We are inviting those who wish to participate in this reunion to contact the reunion organizers, Travis Manning and Reg Norby, or the department. My colleagues and I hope to see many friends of the Department at this event.
