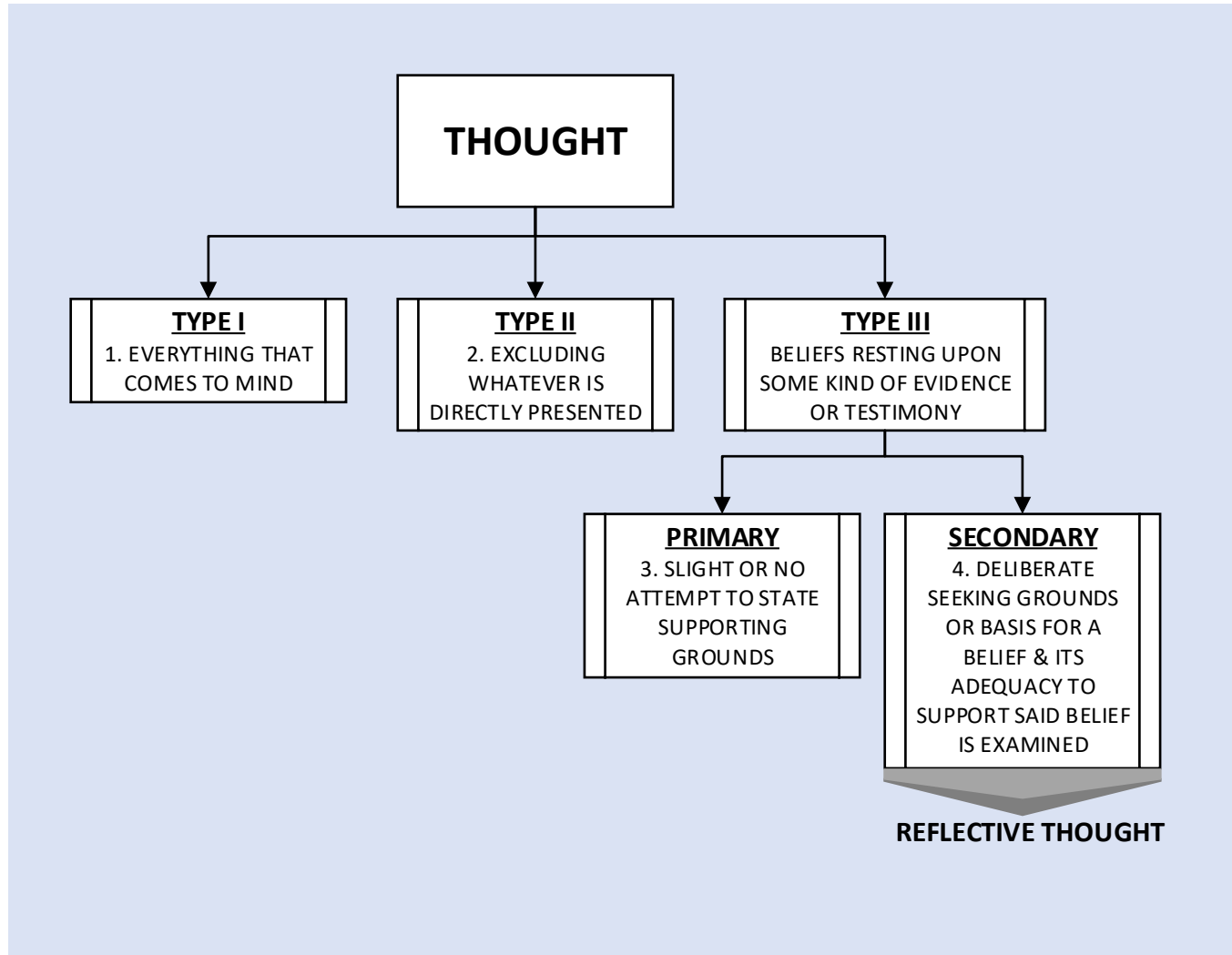
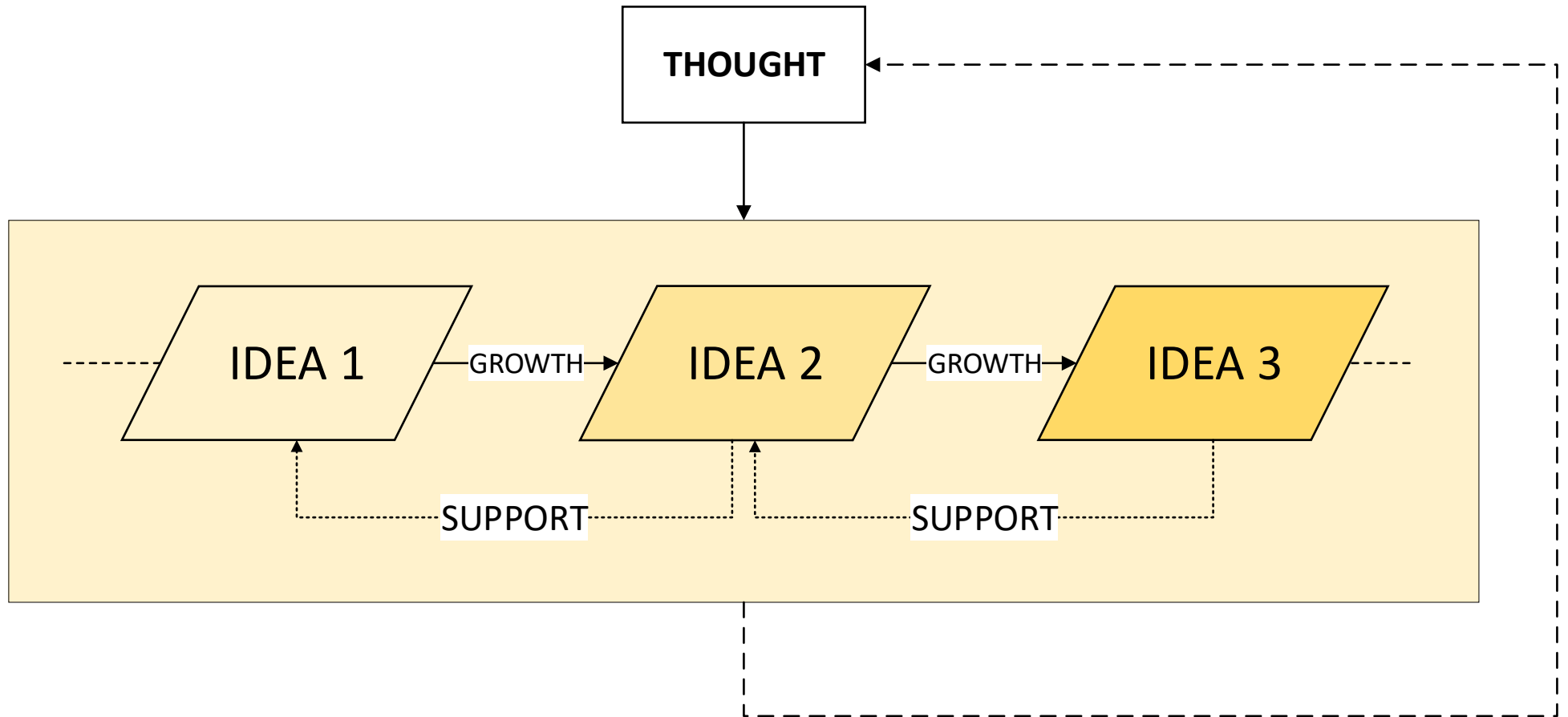


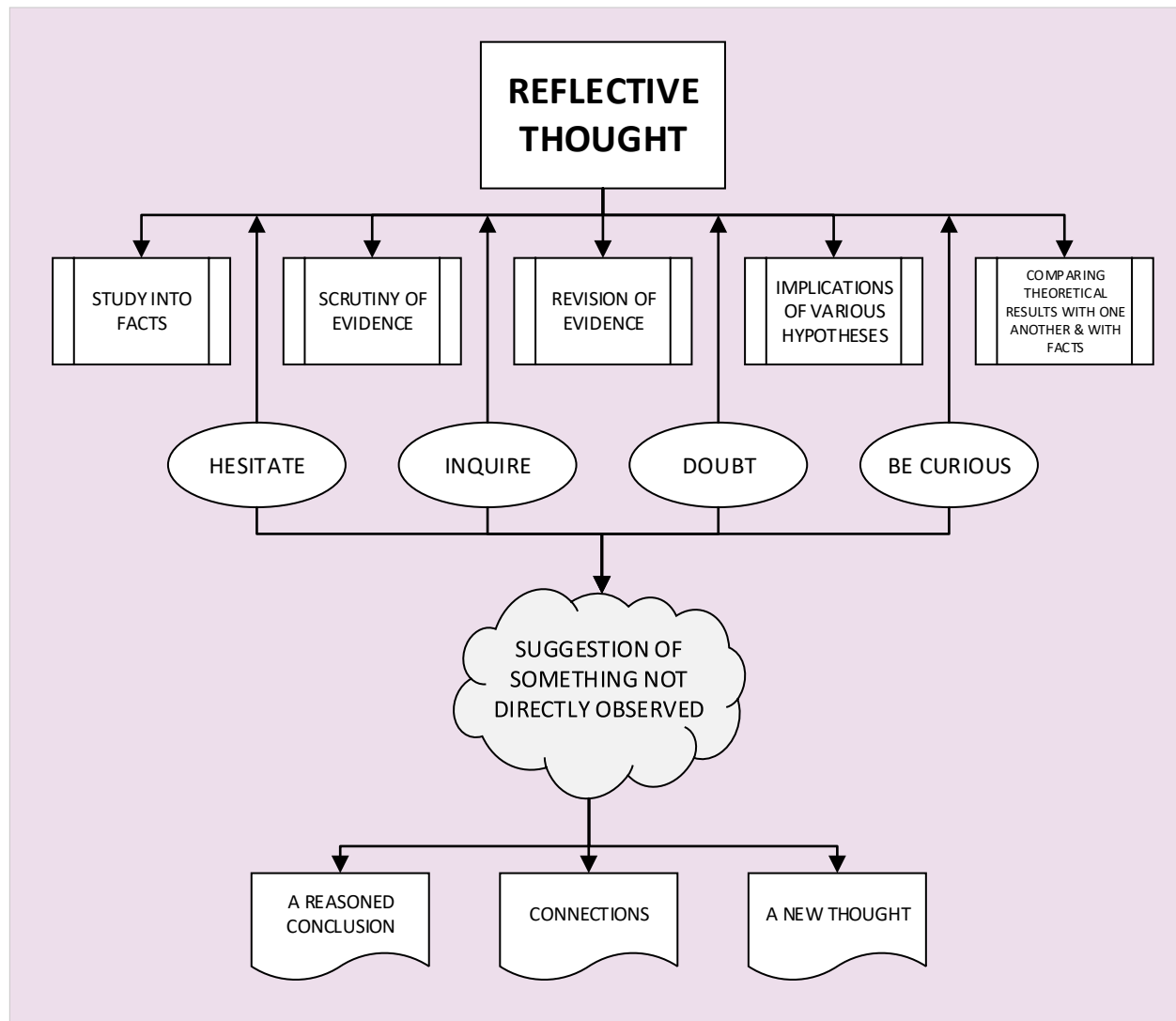

Ideas: *"...terms of thought; the deposit to be utilized in the next term."*

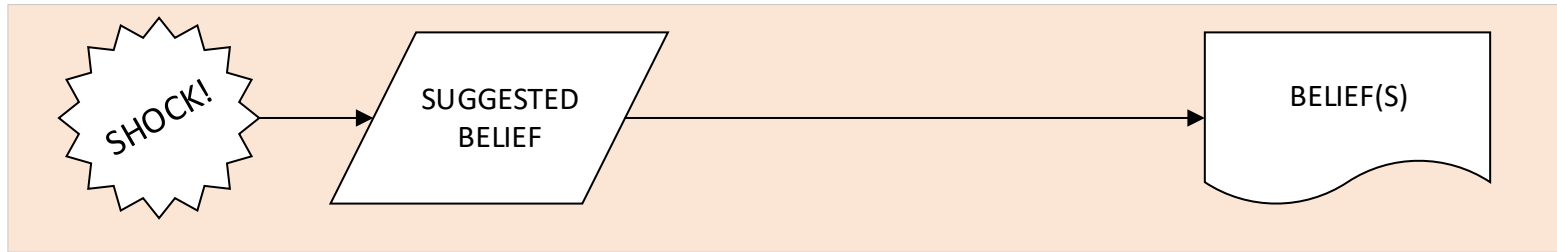


Reflective thought: Not simply a sequence of ideas, but a *consequence* of ideas.

“Active persistent, and careful consideration of any belief or supposed form of knowledge in light of the grounds that support it, and the further conclusions to which it tends.”

“Reflection thus implies that something is believed in (or disbelieved in), not on its own direct account, but through something else which stands as witness, evidence, proof, voucher, warrant; that is, as grounds of belief.”
