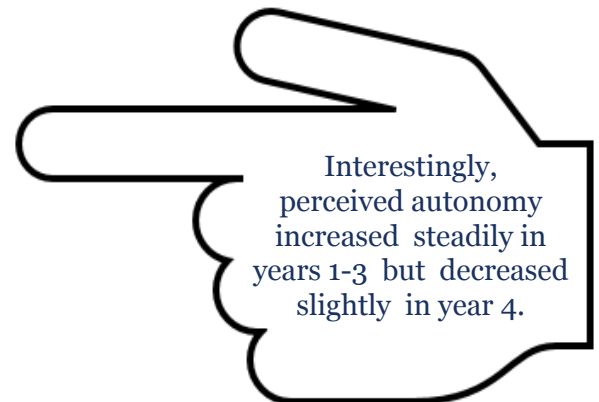
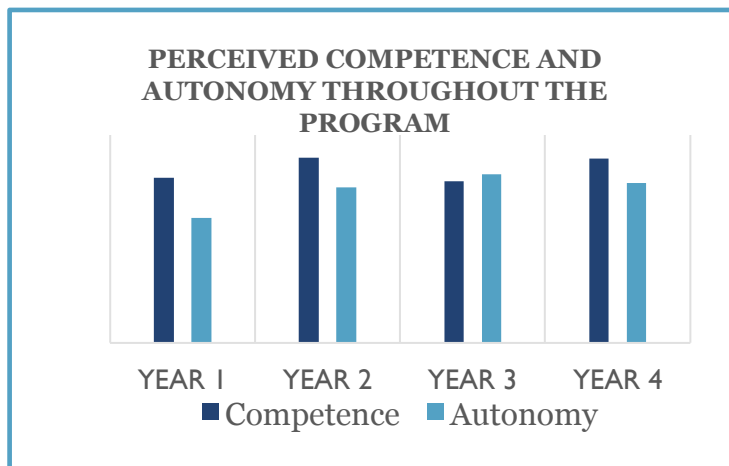


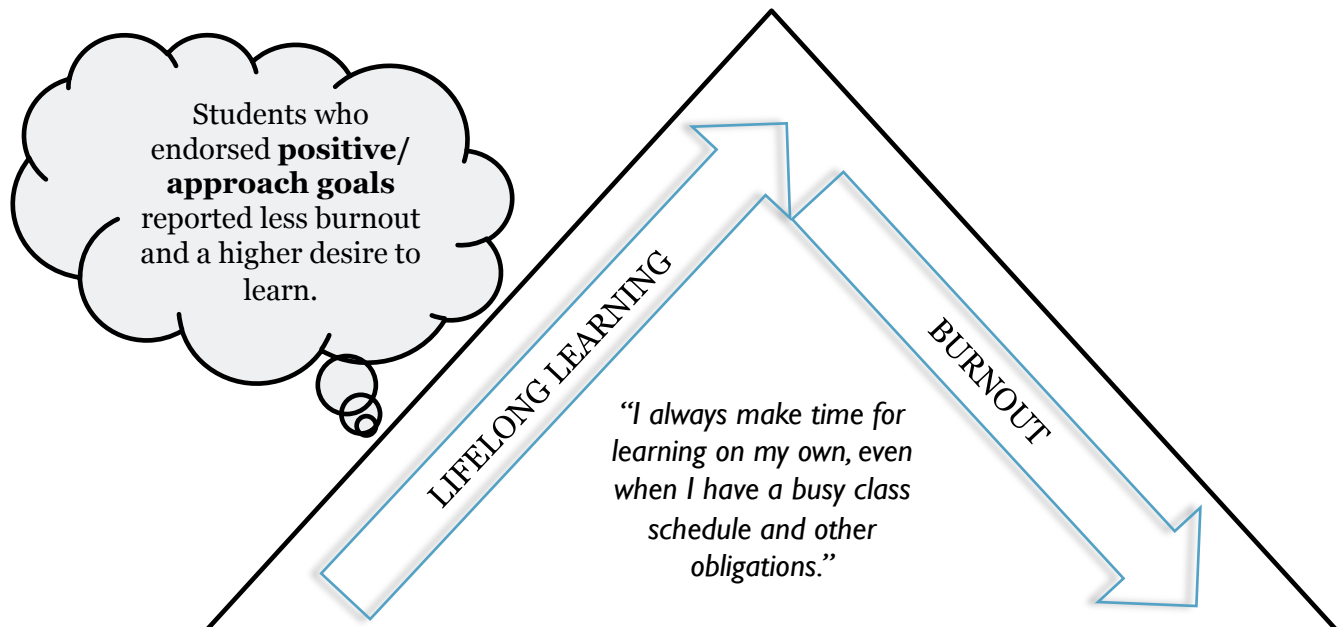
# Research Brief: Medical Student Motivations
