

Purpose:

Develop a communication framework between the City of Camrose and human services to disseminate climate risk and response information to vulnerable populations within the Camrose municipality.



Steps Taken:

• Reviewed literature on climate risks, outreach networks, and accessible

Outcomes/Results:

Our team has created two deliverables:

• **Index:** A document containing contact information for 23 primary contact and working group organizations representing key vulnerable populations.

Implications:

• The City should build off of this model by confirming primary and working group contacts, and updating the index
