Snapshot: AGIIG CLA 2012

What we knew:

- move to digital government publications, no print distribution via DSP
- no LAC web archiving programs (available to the public)
- no comprehensive, national digital preservation planning (people were talking about portals, not preservation)
- web content disappearing from government sites (all levels)
- timeline: "Why is this link dead? Aren't government publications all online?" Access 2013. http://hdl.handle.net/10402/era.34040







Snapshot: Summer 2012

What we had:

- group of librarians who needed long-term access to government publications in order to serve their communities of users
- Council of Prairie and Pacific University Libraries (COPPUL) members with LOCKSS experience and partner status
- Digital Preservation Officer (UofA)
- DSP managers who cared about stewardship and were willing to work with us
- LOCKSS US-Docs membership (UofA, now SFU as well)
- LOCKSS encouragement and support

LOCKSS Program Basics

LOCKSS = Lots of Copies Keeps Stuff Safe

- tamper evident, distributed preservation system
- based at Stanford: http://www.lockss.org/

Five Principles

- 1. libraries have local control of assets
- 2. perpetual access is guaranteed
- 3. preserve original version
- 4. decentralized, distributed preservation
- 5. affordable

Digital Federal Depository Library Program


- attempts to replicate Federal Depository Library Program in the digital environment
- 36 partner libraries
- FDsys (Federal Digital System) content

Canadian Government Information Private LOCKSS Network

- new solution to old problems: stewardship and preservation
- emulates print depository structure
- driven by need for digital preservation
- DSP e-archive content






Moving Forward
