This is the second in a series of annual concerts to be known as "The NICHOLAS ARTHUR KILBURN MEMORIAL CONCERTS." They are dedicated by his sons to the memory of Nicholas Arthur Kilburn, a member of the Board of Governors of the University of Alberta during the 1920's.

Nicholas Kilburn, an Englishman, emigrated to Canada in 1905 and with his English bride began his Canadian life on a homestead near Lloydminster where two sons Nicholas Welden and Peter were born. The family moved to Edmonton in 1916 after having lived in both Provost and Red Deer.

Welden, who followed a musical career, lives in Toronto: Peter who took a B.A. at the University of Alberta in 1929, lives in Montreal.
