Born in Cuba, **Beatriz Boizan** began studying at the age of six with her grandmother Esclarecida Guilarte, and continued her studies at the National School of Music in Havana where she graduated with the Music Diploma with Honors in 1995. The following year she came to Vancouver where she completed both the Music Program at Vancouver Community College King Edward Campus in 1999 and the Bachelor of Music Degree at the University of British Columbia in 2002 under the guidance of Professor Rena Sharon. 1998, Miss Boizan studied with Gyorgy Sandor at the Paloma O'Shea Piano Summer Courses in Santander, Spain. Since 1999, she has attended piano masterclasses with Mme Alicia de Larrocha who encouraged her to study the Spanish repertoire under her guidance. She is presently working towards her Master of Music degree at the University of Alberta Department of Music with Dr Jacques Després.

Some of the notable awards she has received are the Imasco Scholarship (1996-1997), MacPherson Music Scholarship (1996-1997), and the British Columbia Arts Council Music Scholarship (1997-1998), Beryl Barns Memorial Award (2002), and others. She has also won the first prize in the 1997 Concerto-Aria Competition celebrated at Vancouver Community College King Edward Campus.
