

The road to successful grant funding: Tips for trainees and junior faculty in basic and translational research programs

Christian Beaulieu, Rhonda Bell, Joel Dacks and Lonnie Zwaigenbaum

This workshop will provide an overview of strategies to help with success in grant applications at an early career stage, focusing on the grant application process from beginning to end. The panelists come from diverse backgrounds in basic and clinical/translational research.

Topics will include: the fundamentals of good grant writing; how to get started on the process; formulating a compelling question and developing a convincing rationale; tailoring the proposal to the application format; positioning for successful peer reviews; and common pitfalls and how to avoid them. Panelists will provide brief comments, drawing from personal experience as both researchers and reviewers, followed by panel discussion.

Attendees will gain an appreciation of the following skills through the workshop learning objectives:

- Understand the steps required in designing and executing a basic or clinical study.
- Identify who to talk to before preparing a grant.
- Understand the key pillars needed to create a solid foundation for the grant.
- Outline the key steps in preparing a grant.
- Maximize success through the peer review process.

Christian Beaulieu is a professor in biomedical engineering and is the scientific director of the Peter S Allen MR Research Centre. After holding previous salary awards from Alberta Innovates, he is now the Canada Research Chair Tier 1 in Magnetic Resonance Imaging of Brain Micro-structure. His research interests include the development of novel MRI methods primarily for brain and their application to healthy development and aging as well as stroke, epilepsy, fetal alcohol spectrum disorders, etc. He has participated in numerous grant reviews including various CIHR panels (he is currently the University of Alberta CIHR university delegate) and Heart and Stroke Foundation, as well as ad hoc reviews for NSERC and CFI.

Rhonda Bell is a professor of Human Nutrition in the Deptartment of Agricultural, Food and Nutritional Sciences at the University of Alberta. She has a long-standing interest in promoting maternal-child health through optimal maternal dietary intake and studies in her research group span from animal models to human clinical and community-based studies. She is the WCHRI theme lead for healthy development and the lead investigator of ENRICH, a group of integrated complex interventions working with different communities to promote optimal maternal health. She has participated in a wide range of grant review panels.









Joel Dacks studies the evolution of membrane-trafficking organelles using genomics and bioinformatics. He obtained his PhD from Dalhousie University and followed with postdoctoral fellowships at the NHM London and Cambridge University. He began his lab at the University of Alberta in 2008 and is now an associate professor in the Department of Cell Biology. He is the Canada Research Chair Tier 2 in evolutionary cell biology and a scientific associate at the NHM London. His ongoing interest is the scope of organellar diversity in eukaryotic cells and investigating the fundamental mechanisms by which cellular compartments evolve, particularly by processes other than endosymbiosis.

Lonnie Zwaigenbaum is a professor in the Department of Pediatrics and division director of developmental pediatrics. He holds the Stollery Children's Hospital Foundation Chair in Autism and co-directs the Autism Research Centre at the Glenrose Rehabilitation Hospital. His research focuses on early development in autism and related neurodevelopmental disorders. Other research includes genetic studies of autism, a national longitudinal study of developmental trajectories and outcomes in newly diagnosed preschool children with autism, and research on health care experience of families of children with autism. He also directs the national Autism Research Training Program and is a former chair of a CIHR grant review panel.

Politics, ethics, and relationships: Personal experiences with engaged health research

The presenters are the awardees of WCHRI's Patient and Community Engagement Training Program (PaCET) 2016/2017. PaCET brings together a group of students and postdoctoral fellows who have engaged non-academic, patient and community partners in tackling complex questions related to women's and/or children's health. Through "community of practice" as a method of learning from each other and from the experts, PaCET awardees explore different issues arising from the conduct of their research.

The learning objectives of this workshop are to share the challenges and rewards in navigating dynamics of engaged health research by focusing on the following topics:

- Relationships with patient/community stakeholders (building, maintaining and ending).
- Expectations of different research partners.
- Impact of engaged research on the academic and personal growth of the researcher.
- politics (organizational/systemic barriers) and Politics (socio-political barriers) in engaged research.
- Maximize success through the peer review process.

Bethan Kingsley is a postdoctoral fellow with the Community-University Partnership (CUP) for the Study of Children, Youth and Families in the Faculty of Extension. She does community-based research and is currently involved with the Evaluation Capacity Network, which supports evaluation in the social sector. The purpose of Kingsley's WCHRI-funded research was to build a model of supportive housing for teen mothers and their children in partnership with Terra Centre and Brentwood Community Development Group.

Jocelyn Shulhan is a registered dietitian and research assistant with an interest in complex pediatric nutrition needs. She started working as a research assistant at the Alberta Research Centre for Health Evidence in 2011 while studying nutrition at the University of Alberta. In 2015, Shulhan completed the Integrated Dietetic Internship and began a casual position at the Stollery Children's Hospital as a dietitian. Shulhan recently finished a master's degree in medical sciences in the Department of Pediatrics which focused on preterm infant nutrition and parent priorities for future clinical trials. Jocelyn continues to work as a pediatric clinical dietitian and research assistant and looks forward to building a career as a clinician scientist.

Tasneem Siyam is a fourth year PhD student in the Faculty of Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences, University of Alberta. She is also a certified diabetes and travel health educator. Tasneem holds a bachelor's degree in pharmacy from Cairo University and a master's of science in pharmacy from the University of Alberta. She is a passionate researcher and her areas of interest include epidemiology, biostatistics and patient-oriented research especially in the context of women's health. She is currently working her thesis project on improving the health outcomes of women who go through early surgical menopause by developing a decision aid tool that can help these women manage complex health decisions related to managing menopause and its long-term health risks.

Lisa Tink is currently in the PhD program in the School of Public Health at the University of Alberta. Prior to beginning her PhD, Lisa worked as a director in the Recreation and Physical Activity Division in Alberta Culture and Tourism and a manager at Alberta and Recreation Parks Association. Lisa's research explores the social and political arrangements that have created the conditions for our current recreation system.

How can researchers and policy makers truly communicate with each other?

Andreas Laupacis

Knowledge translation (KT) is about encouraging researchers to do research that answers questions of interest to policy-makers, and having policy-makers use the best available evidence when making policy decisions. Not surprisingly, this is easier said than done. Laupacis has over 30 years' experience as a researcher, including six as CEO of the Institute for Clinical Evaluative Sciences, an organization whose mandate includes doing policy relevant research. He has also been on the policy end as the board chair of Health Quality Ontario. Laupacis will share his observations of the different cultures of policy making and research (which can sometimes unwittingly become barriers to KT) and lead a discussion about how KT can be optimized.

The learning objectives of this workshop are to help participants:

- improve their understanding, knowledge and attitudes related to cultural differences between research and policy, especially with respect to KT;
- develop effective KT research plans, incorporating policy-makers from the start; and,
- identify strategies to link with stakeholders and policy- and decision-makers for more effective KT.

Andreas Laupacis is also the keynote speaker.

Andreas Laupacis Why is an evidence-based guy like me telling healthcare stories?

12:20 – 1:15 p.m. *Ballroom*

Stories and case reports are at the bottom of the hierarchy of evidence that is widely accepted within health care (systematic reviews of high quality randomized trials are at the top). The health care system is a hierarchy, which works for making decisions about treatment and diagnosis, but there is much more to high quality health care than that. Laupacis will share examples from a patient and provider stories website (www.facesofhealthcare.ca) to illustrate the importance of stories, and argue for greater integration of quantitative and qualitative "evidence" within health care.



Andreas Laupacis is a general internist and the executive director of the Li Ka Shing Knowledge Institute of St. Michael's Hospital. He is a professor at the University of Toronto in the Faculty of Medicine and the Institute of Health Policy, Management and Evaluation.

Laupacis has published over 350 peer-reviewed articles covering a variety of topics in clinical epidemiology, health services research, health technology assessment and health policy. He engages the public about health care issues (he founded www.healthydebate.ca and www.facesofhealthcare.ca), and holds a Canada Research Chair in Health Policy and Citizen Engagement.

He has served on numerous academic and governmental advisory committees and currently is the board chair for Health Quality Ontario. Laupacis has been awarded the Justice Emmett Hall Laureate (2010), the Health Services Research Advancement Award from the Canadian Health Services Research Foundation (2011), was the inaugural recipient of the CIHR's Barer-Flood Prize in Health Services and Policy Research (2013) and is a Fellow of the Royal Society of Canada (2015).
