#### FOREWORD

#### **Challenges and Achievements: Rural Economy in 1993**

The year 1993 encompassed challenges and achievements for the Department of Rural Economy. Staff contributed to developing the new undergraduate programs of the Faculty that were launched so successfully in September 1993. Rural Economy continues to provide rural social science course offerings to students in the programs in this Faculty, including the Agriculture and Forestry Bachelors degree programs, the Agriculture/Food Business Management program (this is a joint program with the Faculty of Business) and the Environmental and Conservation Sciences (ENCS) program. The latter has proved to be very popular. Nearly one-quarter of the students in the ENCS program are choosing to major in the Environmental Economics and Policy specialization, giving Rural Economy a substantial role in their studies.

Rural Economy's graduate programs continued to draw excellent students--51 in total in 1993--both from Canada and many other nations. Numbers of students held prestigious scholarships and awards. Others were supported by research grants of faculty; these grants increased in number and value in 1993. The M.Sc. thesis of Jo Ann Sandhu was recognized as an Outstanding Masters' Thesis by the Canadian Agricultural Economics and Farm Management Society. New directions and ventures included the development of agroforestry specializations in the M.Sc. and M.Ag. programs. A joint specialization in environmental and natural resource economics in the Ph.D. programs in Rural Economy and Economics was introduced.

Staff and students in Rural Economy, with the assistance of colleagues from Alberta Agriculture and the Alberta Agricultural Economics Association, hosted the 1993 joint annual meeting of two major groups--the Western Agricultural Economics Association (which encompasses agricultural economists from the Western U.S. and Canada) and the Canadian Agricultural Economics and Farm Management Society. Many friends of the department helped with the successful local arrangements for this meeting. This was followed by a reunion of previous and current alumni and staff. It is pleasing to note that as a result of fund raising associated with donations made by previous and current students and staff, an endowment fund for the Rural Economy's Eric Berg Reading Room is being established.

Changes occurred as two staff members moved on to new challenges in their lives. Barb Johnson, who headed the Reading Room for the previous 11 years, married Malcolm Profitt and now lives in Canmore. Joan Fulton moved to an Assistant Professor position at Colorado State University, Fort Collins. Gail Robinson joined Rural Economy as librarian. Tim Richards, a native of Red Deer, completing Ph.D. studies at Stanford University, was a visiting Assistant Professor in Rural Economy. Len Bauer and Bill Phillips returned from study and administrative leaves, while Vic Adamowicz and Mel Lerohl left on study leaves.

The focus in Rural Economy on international studies and research continued throughout 1993 with numbers of staff and students involved in the rural outreach project with Maejo University in northern Thailand, as well as the on-going project on the valuation of trees with the University of Zimbabwe and a project to strengthen institutions in Kenya. Visiting scholars from China, Thailand, Zimbabwe, the United States and Australia worked in the department during 1993. Canadian graduate students in Rural Economy worked on field research in The Gambia, Lesotho, Zimbabwe and Thailand.

In 1993 Rural Economy was the recipient, for the third year, of the Alberta Agricultural Research Institute Professorship award in Marketing, held by Jim Eales. The Industry-University Council directing the newly endowed program of the Cooperative Chair in Agricultural Marketing and Business established the selection committee for this chair, a position that will contribute to teaching and research in Rural Economy.

The year ahead will continue to pose challenges of constrained resources. It is our objective to meet these by building and maintaining excellence in teaching and research in selected areas of social science that are of importance to rural people and rural activities.
