many persons and perhaps even loss of life." The leader he added, had a "serious moral obligation" to consider marches; "with a heavy heart," he urged them so to do CFM supporter, Robert Johnson of the United Auto Workers changed his mind. In March, he had vowed that "the U thing all the way." But on August 11, Johnson joined others in meeting Daley and then endorsing Cody's plea.<sup>43</sup>

This sudden hemorrhage of white support caused agony within the CFM, but it failed to stop the marches. The Board affirmed that "those who would express their conviction through nonviolent demonstrations must be protected. Mississippi, Young wired Cody that a pause would be considered in Chicago, however, Bevel and Raby rejected Cody's appeal. "Archbishop . . . not to abandon us now," Raby urged. Bevel castigated Cody for deserting the movement: "When the Daley sticks up his liberal bishop to say, 'You've gone for Well, we've got news for the man. If the bishop doesn't agree to speak up for Christ, let him join the devil." The bishop made his statement, Bevel led five hundred marches the Loop, stopping outside the office of the Chicago Reverend. Two days later, Bevel, Jackson, and Raby took seven hundred half of them white, into Bogan. When local reaction was expected, they decided to hold simultaneous marches in Grant Park, and Jefferson Park on August 14. No date had been set for the Cicero march, but the tactic of multiple marches, which police to the limit, served equally well. About one thousand took part in Sunday's triple protest. Although they were met with the usual barrage of bricks and bottles, the most serious violence came from the marchers in Grant Park. Park

### Description

One of many conversions of the famous block-stacking game available for Nintendo's home console, this one is based on the 1988 coin-op version produced by Atari Games. The goal is to place pieces made up of four tiles in a ten-by-twenty well, organizing them into complete rows, which then disappear. As rows are cleared, the pace of the game increases, and the game ends if the stack reaches the top of the well.

The game features a standard endless mode, as well as a two-player competitive mode where players race to complete each level. There is also a "cooperative" mode where both players play within the same well, working together to complete lines. Both the competitive mode and the cooperative mode can also be played with the computer.

share some similar characteristics in regard to their impacts on ecosystems and they are both keystone species (Table 2). Nevertheless, the parks have different sizes and densities of their largest herbivores (Table 1). We recognize that it is difficult to select two parks with enough similar characteristics to allow for fair comparisons of their management strategies; we chose these parks because they are home to their continent's largest herbivores, the parks are fenced, and we have some familiarity with them.

Depending on definitions used, these two species might be overabundant in their respective parks. Following Parks Canada's policy, a hyperabundant wildlife population meets one of the following conditions: 1) exceeds the upper range of natural variability and impacts ecological integrity, 2) has resulted from alteration of natural mechanisms for population regulation, 3) there is a risk of negatively affecting native species at risk, and 4) the population has caused impacts beyond the historical range of variation.<sup>14</sup> By this definition, bison in EINP are hyperabundant. Parks Canada is required to manage hyperabundant populations to maintain or restore ecological integrity. Methods to manage hyperabundant populations should best contribute to restoring or maintaining ecological integrity, mimic natural processes, and have been found to be effective on similar species. KNP also adheres to these standards and, though the term hyperabundant is not used

in South African legislation, their [National Norms and Standards for the Management of Elephants in South Africa](#)<sup>15</sup> does outline the impacts elephants can have and what measures can be taken when management plan objectives are not met due to population size or distribution. KNP's elephant population is recorded to have impacts on vegetation and, therefore, other species<sup>12</sup> thereby hindering KNP's biodiversity management objective.<sup>15</sup> Therefore, given the impacts of the elephant population in KNP coupled with Parks Canada's definition and the information from the Norms and Standards<sup>15</sup>, both populations can be defined as hyperabundant.

The main methods employed to deal with abundant populations of large herbivores are translocation, contraception, culling, and non-management.<sup>1,3,13</sup> Another less common method is distribution control. Non-management is not an option for elephants in KNP because their population is too large and is not an option for EINP because of its small land area and lack of predators. The remaining methods will be discussed in relation to the management of elephants in KNP and bison in EINP and how they are employed from different strategic points of view (i.e. impact control for KNP versus numbers control for EINP). When developing and implementing a wildlife management plan, park managers need to consider the advantages and disadvantages of each of these methods, as well as the behaviour of the species on which they are being applied.
