

Guidelines where Applicants are Required by the Sponsor to Apply for Grants as Individuals

In grants where applicants are required to apply directly to the sponsor as individuals and not through the university, no U of A signatures are required.

Check with your Chair, Faculty Associate or Vice Dean of Research to ensure that your project is not in conflict with your role at the university and in accordance with your collective agreements.

Guidelines for Managing the Grant: If awarded, you will be personally responsible for managing the funds (i.e. the funds will not be managed through a University account) and any reporting and income tax requirements related to any grant funding received. The University will not be able to provide any guidance or advice on this. It will be up to you to decide if you need to seek personal tax advice and if so to do this on your own.
