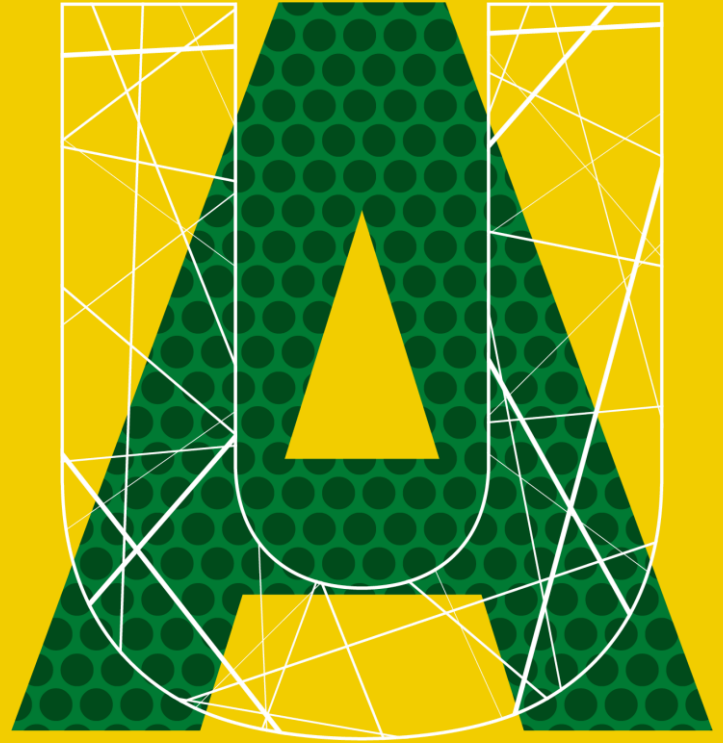

Kinji IMANISHI (1902-1992) was an entomologist, ecologist, anthropologist, founder of Japanese primatology, and an accomplished mountaineer, who had great popularity as an explorer among the Japanese public and was twice honored by the Emperor of Japan. Although his published works are well known, the existence of approximately 8000 unpublished pages of his personal notes and papers dating from 1919-1980 is largely unknown and makes up the content of this archive. Below you will find thumbnails of the 23 categories that Kinji Imanishi used to organize his Notebooks. Each box contains a brief description of the contents of the materials. At the end of each description the languages in which the materials are written is noted. The first mentioned language is the predominant language of each set of materials. The separate categories contain from 1-16 volumes of notebooks, or up to 21 separate maps. Drafts of papers and letters also contain several separate sets. 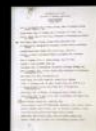

Africa, Europe, USA Trip 1958

In 1958 Imanishi and Itani Junichiro traveled to Africa, Europe and USA to meet with primate researchers and psychologists, and to identify potential great ape research fieldsites. These documents include lists of scientists and their affiliations, hotel receipts, trip costs and various notes on conversational English. These papers can be seen in conjunction with the diaries Imanishi kept of their trip, called the Africa Field Notebooks 1958.

Although his published works are gathered in a 14 volume Collected Works, the existence of approximately 8000 unpublished pages of his personal notes and papers dating from 1919-1980 is largely unknown. In 2001 this large collection was rediscovered by his eldest son, Bunatar IMANISHI in his family home in Kyoto, Japan. These papers were found neatly bound in separate bundles or in boxes and envelopes in the family home.

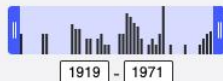

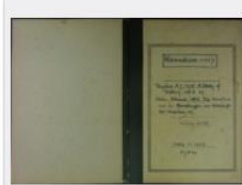

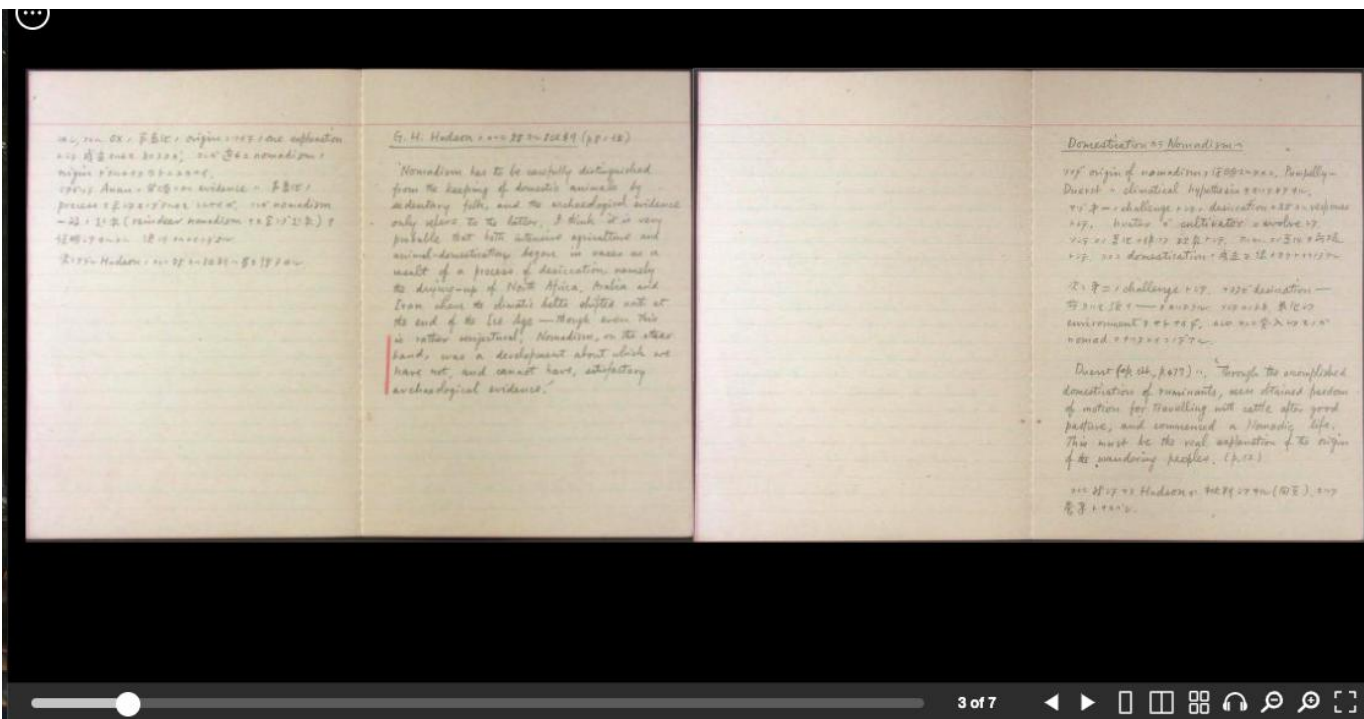
