

### Overview of the DDA Program at MacEwan

- Pilot project in 2010
- DDA-preferred
- ProQuest and EBSCO
- Checks and balances



# **Positive Aspects**

- Patron-driven
- Library purchasing power
- Trendy topics
- Mainstream



# **Negative Aspects**

- Titles pulled by publisher
- Not every title available as DDA
- Waiting periods



# DDA in a time of COVID and Budget Restrictions

#### COVID

- Initially, DDA
- Now, not as expected
- Freeze print and e, convert to DDA


#### **BUDGET**

- Used as a budget reduction strategy
- Freeze print and e, convert to DDA
- Too conservative



#### Future of DDA at MacEwan

- Weeding
- Ongoing monitoring
- Content on publisher platforms





#### Overview of DDA at U of A

- E-preferred since 2013
- DDA = one of several approaches to building our ebook collection
- Via ProQuest: ebooks are selected through the approval plan process
- Via JSTOR: ebooks are added based on participating publishers



# Effects of pandemic (& cuts...)

- Shifting more publishers to DDA
- Making DDA more central in firm-ordering



#### **Benefits & Drawbacks**



- What MacEwan colleagues have said!
- Helps ensure relevance
- Well-suited for publishers we may not perceive as core or essential
- Collecting as assessment



- Maintaining knowledge of complex DDA-specific details, e.g., trigger thresholds
- Price escalation within the DDA pool
- Managing (mitigating) duplication



# **How DDA records are loaded**





# 'Unpurchased' MARC Records

- Records received from vendors
- Loaded same as other ebooks
- Title Control Number retained for future matching (eg. on1098174186, EBC6521945)
- Lower cataloguing quality accepted



#### 'Purchased' MARC Records

- Records received from vendors
- Existing 'unpurchased' records replaced with new records (manual edit or overlay report)
- Update Item Cat 2 (eg. EBCPDA to EBCPDAP)
- Record upgraded to higher quality



- Effort made to avoid duplication
- Weekly report IDs any dupes
  - We discard DDA
  - Notify vendor to deactivate DDA
