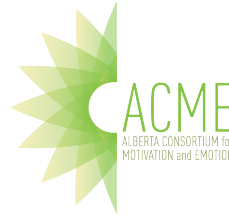


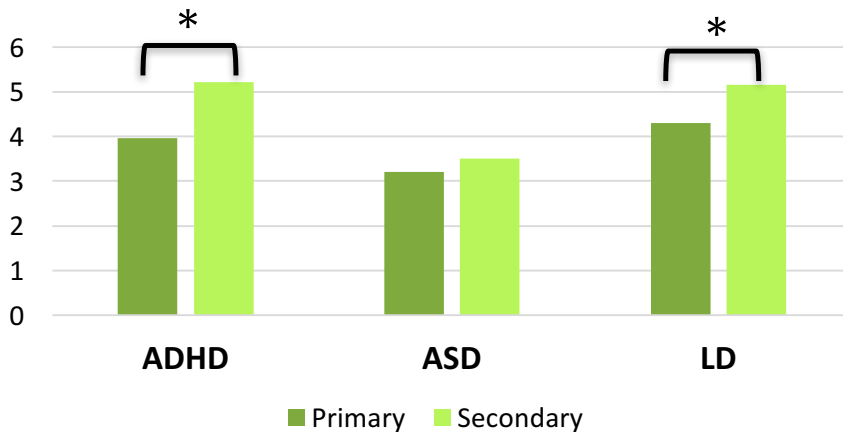

To what extent do you feel the student can control their difficulties?



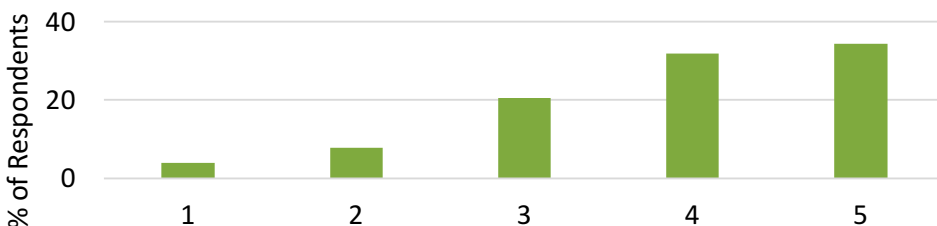
Primary and secondary teachers differ in how much control they feel students have over their difficulties.
