


What is government information?

Information produced by government agencies.


democracy (noun)

Government by the people; *esp.* a system of government in which all the people of a state or polity are involved in making decisions about its affairs, typically by voting to elect representatives to a parliament or similar assembly [OED]

Changes and Challenges

- budget cuts, consolidation of govt libraries: loss of referral system and services for public and librarians outside governments
- transition to digital publishing without comprehensive acquisitions, access, or preservation strategies

Result: less government information distributed and curated in more precarious formats with lower levels of support by government agencies.

Consolidation of Govt Libraries

Government of Canada Libraries

- **Consolidated:** Canada Revenue Agency (9 into 1), Parks Canada (5 into 1), Fisheries & Oceans (2 principal and 2 subsidiary locations, closing seven libraries), Natural Resources (14 into 7)
- **Closed:** Public Service Commission, Citizenship and Immigration Canada, Human Resources & Skills Development (2 libraries closed), Transportation Safety Board, Transport Canada, Public Works & Government Services

- cessation of print distribution as of April 2014
- collecting pdfs only as listed on weekly checklist, searchable via catalogue with stable urls for most titles
- supplemental checklists include digitized content

Open Government Program, Service Alberta

- Pillars: Open Data, Open Information (AGL lead), Open Engagement
- Open Information Portal or "virtual library" will be developed and launched in the next fiscal year; AGL will work to determine scope and develop policy, processes and standards necessary to create and manage the virtual library (Gary Weber, April 2014)

Tamper evident, distributed preservation system based at Stanford.


Five Principles

- 1. libraries have local control of assets
- 2. perpetual access is guaranteed
- 3. preserve original version
- 4. decentralized, distributed preservation
- 5. affordable

Library Funding

In April 1980, the Minister of Culture announced substantial improvements in programmes of assistance to Alberta's public libraries. Per capita grants were more than doubled, a new direct grant eligibility for municipal libraries within regional library systems was established, establishment grants to regional libraries were increased, and a number of levels of service were strengthened. While these announcements were welcomed enthusiastically, the Board will continue to review the level of financial support to libraries in the Province lest services wither through adequate funding.

Schick Information Systems Ltd, was selected as the research firm to carry out the Alberta Library Network Research Project, a study which has as its intended goal the outlining of a choice of system models which will facilitate library resource sharing. Once that decision was made, the Board hosted a public forum in the Jubilee Auditorium, Edmonton, in August 1980, to introduce the Project. At that meeting, the background to the Project was given, the Director of the Project, Ian MacLean, outlined the proposed study itself, and a panel of representatives of the Alberta library community made presentations on concerns about resource sharing in the Province. The meeting, which was attended by participants from academic, school, public, government and special libraries, concluded with a general discussion and question period. Both the project team and the participants indicated their satisfaction with the meeting. The Board expects to have the results of the study in the near future and looks forward to presenting them to the library community for its consideration.
