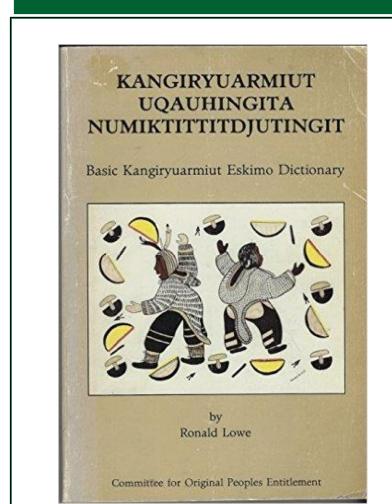
The ICRC has a mandate to:

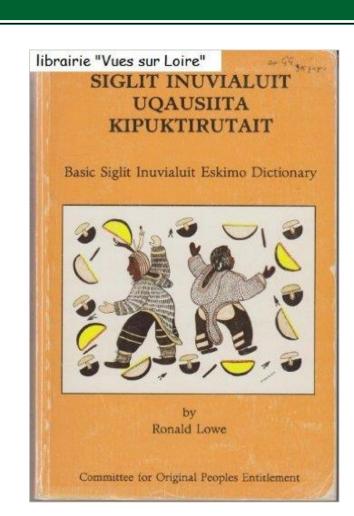
- Preserve the Inuvialuktun language with the assistance of elders.

- -Promote the on-going development of the Inuvialuktun language.

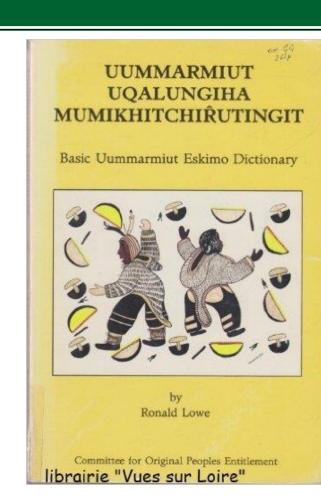
The DLN Research project seeks to develop a digital library that will support collections of material in all of the dialects as well as indexing and search capability in all of the dialects.

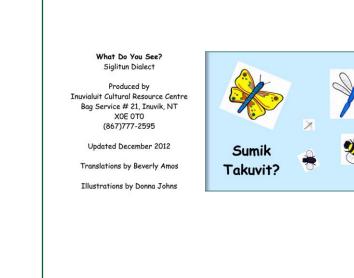


Three Dialects – Three Dictionaries

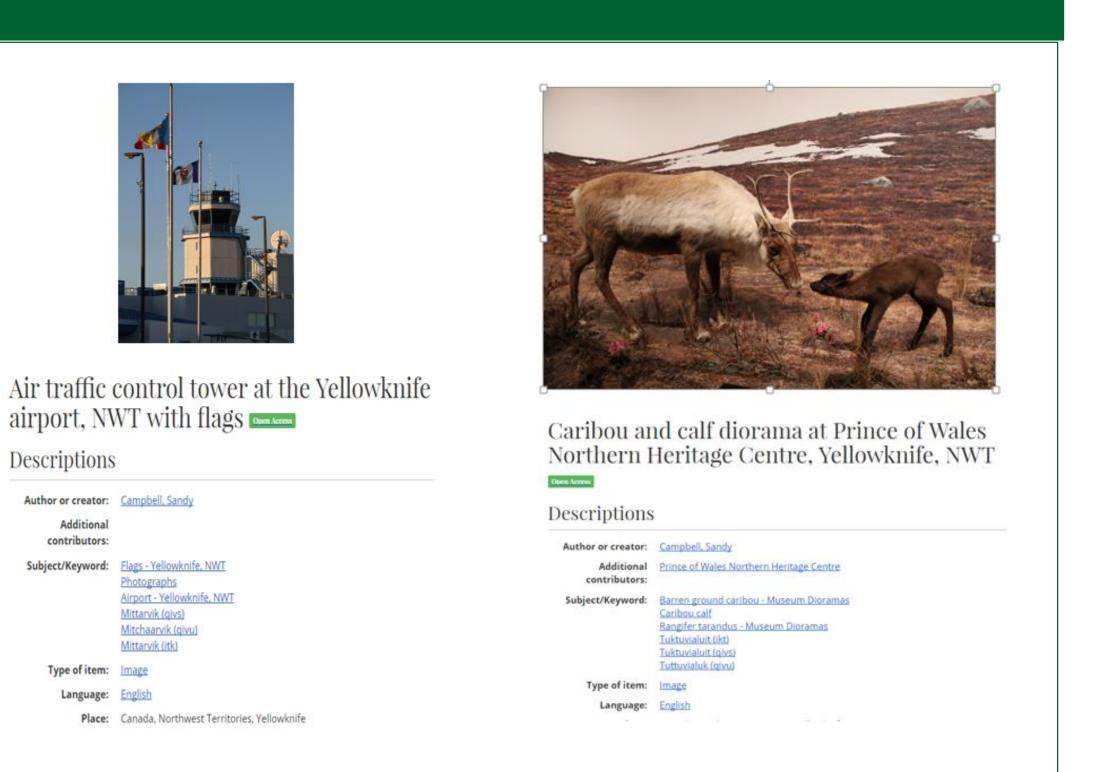

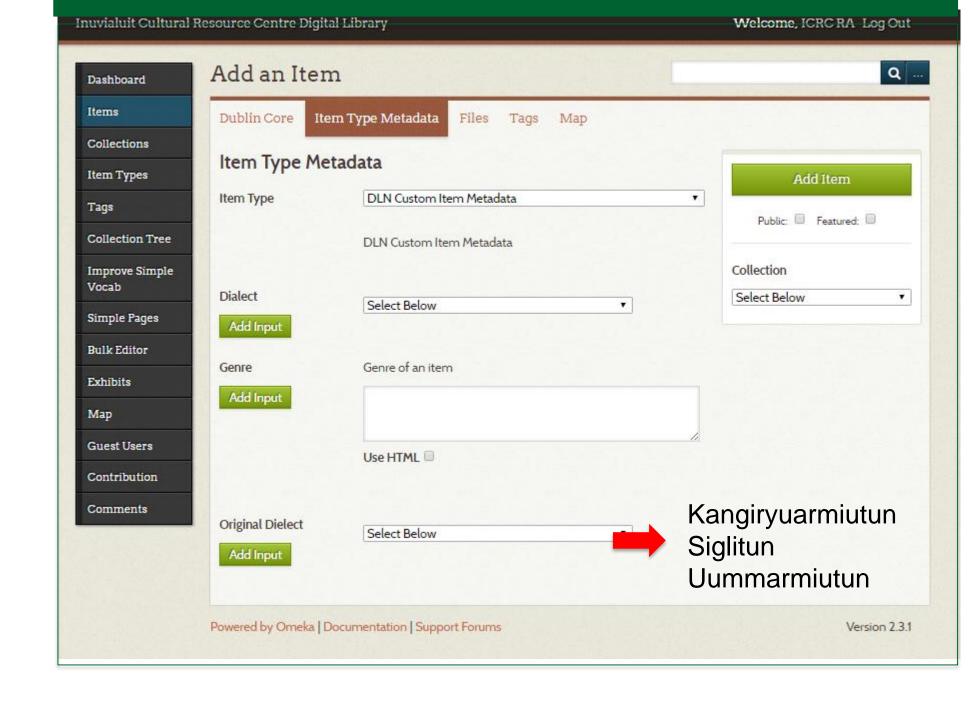
