BOOLEAN OPERATORS





AND always gets <u>less</u> results

Use AND to combine different concepts

BOOLEAN OPERATORS – OR



OR always gets more results

Use OR to combine similar concepts

What it's called	How it's	What it
	used	does
Truncation * NEOS catalogue \$	symbol*	symbol, symbols, symbolism, symbolist, symbolists, symbolic
Wildcard ?	wom?n	wom <i>a</i> n or wom <i>e</i> n
Phrase searching ""	"second language acquisition"	finds "second language acquisition" as an exact phrase

Canadian information in the field of education

Language & Linguists Behavior Abstracts

LLBA (1973 to the present) provides access to the world's literature in linguistics and its various subdisciplines

<u>PsycInfo</u>

Covers the international literature in psychology.

<u>Eric</u>

Covers all aspects of education and all topics within the broad discipline

<u>Google Scholar</u>



Look through your results – are there any terms that are used in other contexts, that may be retrieving irrelevant results?

May want to remove some of your 'OR'd' synonyms

Add an extra concept using **AND**

If you're getting too few results:

Are you missing any important terms?

Remove one of your main concepts

Consider synonyms, alternate spellings and writing out acronyms
