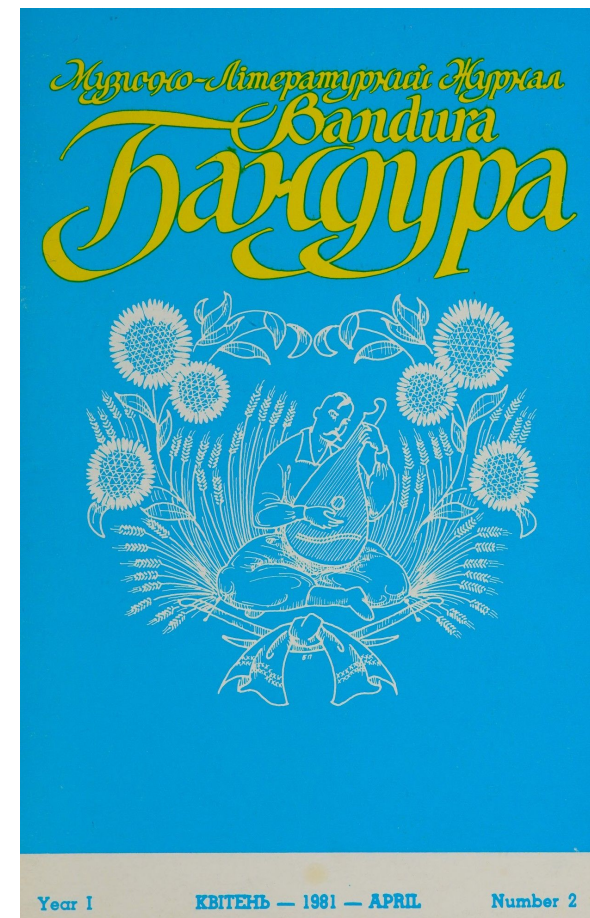

- Our solution for now - non exclusive arrangements for access to our digitized collections
- Current work = **Migrating nearly 67,000** Digitized Newspaper Issues (or 646,000 pages) to the Internet Archive Platform

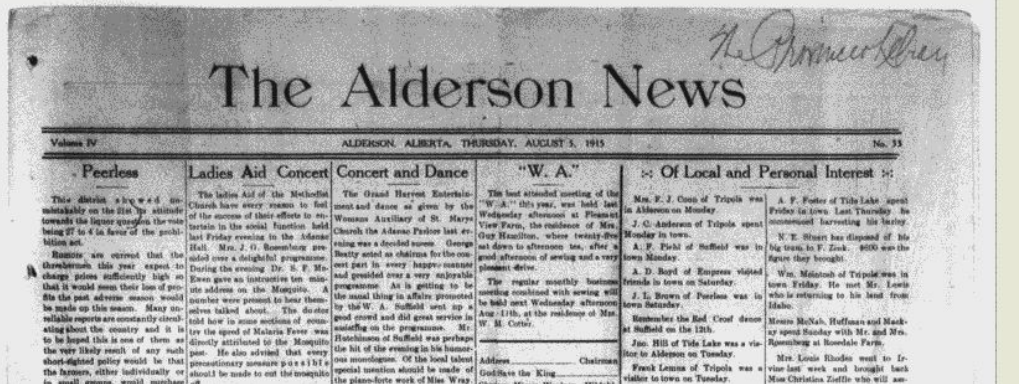

Internet Archive Command Line Interface

- Used for Uploading and Downloading, Editing Metadata, Generating lists of identifiers within collections
- Documented and reasonable learning curve
- Easy to install on MacOS and Linux
- Windows - Hard to manage in more locked down IT environments
 - Windows Subsystem for Linux is your path forward

Uploading your digital content

- Anyone with a Internet Archive account can upload
- Supports image, text, audio/visual, data
- No mediation so files are available quickly
- No (documented) size restrictions
- Automatically creates derivative files



The Kinji Imanishi Digital Archive

Kinji IMANISHI (1902-1992) was an entomologist, ecologist, anthropologist, founder of Japanese primatology, and an accomplished mountaineer, who had great popularity as an explorer among the Japanese public and was twice honored by the Emperor of Japan. Although his published works are gathered in a 14 volume Collected Works, the existence of approximately 8000 unpublished pages of his personal notes and papers dating from 1919-1980 is largely unknown. In 2001 this large collection was rediscovered by his eldest son, Bunatar IMANISHI in his family home in Kyoto, Japan. These papers were found neatly bound in separate bundles or in boxes and envelopes in the family home.

- Creation of a Bash script to automate this process



Derive Issues

- The Derive process is the Internet Archive process for creating the many derivative formats for each item
- Sometimes this process simply fails. This will result in missing derivative files and is often noticeable by a lack of a flip book view.

- Manually restarting the derive process within the problematic record from the history
- If the text quality within the scan is weak, it may be getting stuck at the OCR step - can fix by switching the OCR method
- We have created a custom Bash script to allow us to more easily fix derive problems after a large batch upload.







- **files.xml** file contains all of the file-level metadata (e.g. track title, checksums, etc.).

- You can have as many custom fields as you want
 - Typos in a field name will create a custom field!
- You cannot control where the metadata is shown in the record.
 - For example *licenseurl* is shown very high, but the *rights* field is often hidden under the fold
- Metadata fields and interface labels might be different.
 - For example subject = topics in the interface
- Some fields support rich text and hyperlinks
- Schema doc is not always up to date

- April and May 2023 we downloaded approximately 38TB or 5.7 million files of our data from Internet Archive

What's the Downside?

- Limited Change Management. Ultimately No Control - changes in interface, added metadata to your items
- Limited Communication on outages and platform slowness
- Limited Granularity with User Permissions - all or nothing
- Shared Infrastructure - you can and will be impacted on what others are doing at any given moment on the platform
