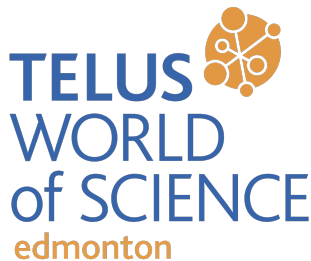

Kristine Wray is a PhD student at the University of Alberta. She will be coordinating a mural project with students!



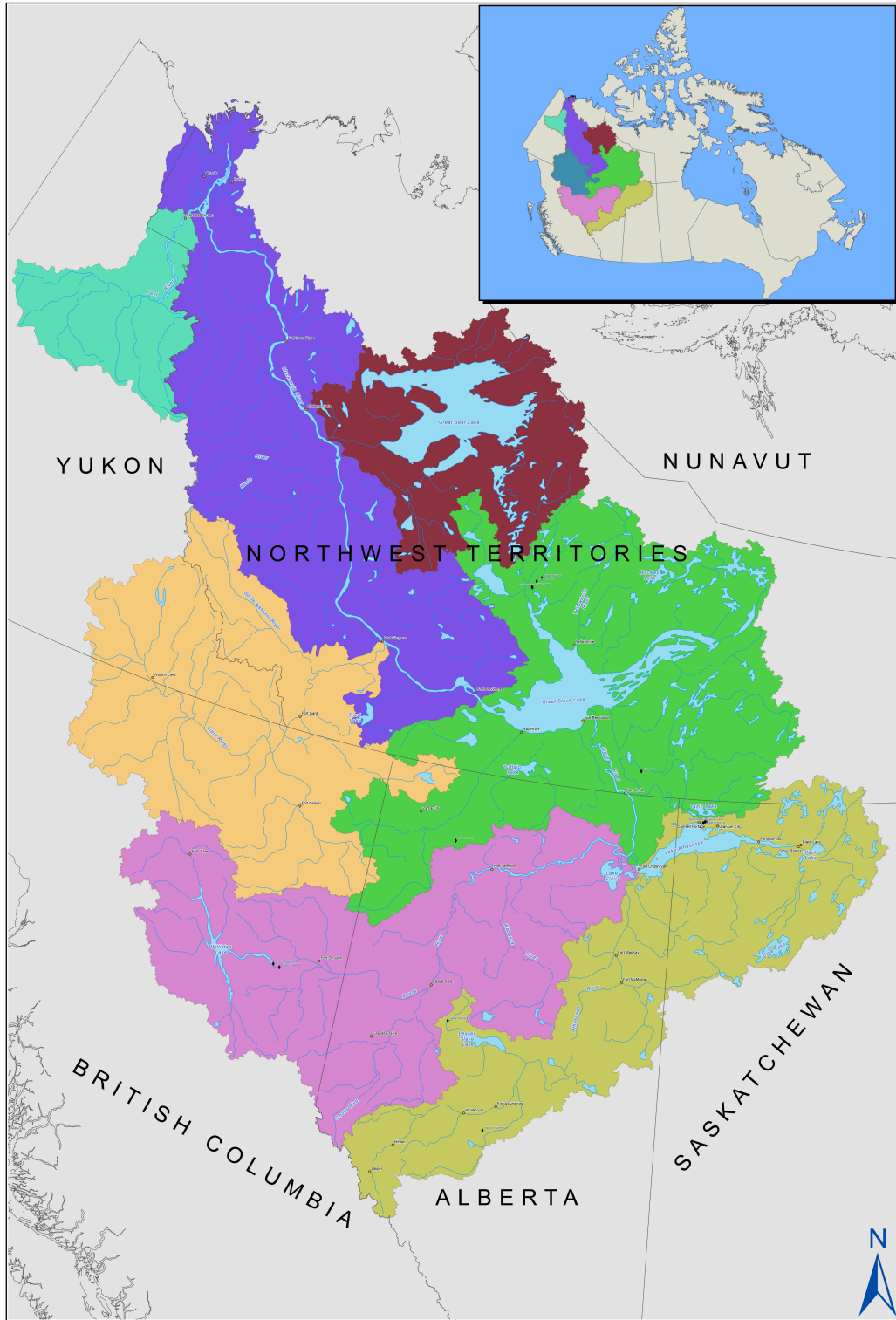
