

Triple Concerto in A minor BWV 1044

J. S. Bach

The *Triple Concerto in A minor*, which is scored for exactly the same instruments as the fifth "Brandenburg" concerto has its origins in two previously written keyboard compositions by the same composer. The first and last movements are based on his *Prelude and Fugue in A minor* for solo harpsichord (BWV 8994) and the slow movement is an adaptation of the F major Adagio e dolce from the *Sonata for Two Manuals and Pedal (organ, clavichord or harpsichord) in D minor (BWV 527)*. Few of Bach's instrumental works surpass the two fast movements of this concerto in breadth of power. The slow movement, which is scored for the three solo instruments alone, is written with great refinement and delicacy.
