(Grave-Larghetto)

(Allegro con fuoco)

v3. Lord, how long shall the ungodly triumph?

v6. They murder the widow, and the stranger: and put the fatherless to death.

v7. And yet they say, Tush, the Lord shall not see: neither shall the God of Jacob regard it.

(Adagio)

v17. If the Lord had not helped me: it had not failed but my soul had been put to silence.

v19. In the multitude of the sorrows that I had in my heart: thy comforts have refreshed my soul.
