# STUDENT FEEDBACK- FALL 2017

During the Fall 2017 semester, 175 students from EDPY 304 (Adolescent Development and Learning) completed our survey that examined students' perspectives on receiving feedback when it comes to course exams. Overall, 131 students responded to our survey after all three of their exams which will provide us with important information on this topic. Thank you to all of our participants! Some preliminary results are presented here.

### What Type of Feedback do Students Want on their Exams?

When given the option after the third exam,

87% wanted to see the feedback form.

#### Percentage vs. Feedback Form

- We looked at differences in student opinions in regards to receiving percentage information versus a feedback form about their completed exam.
- Students felt that the feedback form after exam 2 was preferable to the percentage information that they received after exam 1.

The feedback form was seen as more helpful...

BUT

The formats were equal in encouraging students to put in more effort.





#### Were you Satisfied with your Exam Score?

Students who chose to see the feedback form after the third exam were **more** satisfied with their exam score than those who chose to just see their percentage.
