After the success at its premiere in 1937 of the original version for two solo pianos Milhaud subsequently orchestrated it for saxophone (or clarinet) solo and orchestra. This authorized transcription by Don Stewart retains the original saxophone part and the woodwind parts follow as closely as possible to the composer's own ideas.
