JOHN RADD 1933 - 1991

IN MEMORIAM

John Radd was born in Buffalo, New York. His degrees were earned from the State University of New York at Fredonia, University of Buffalo, and the Eastman School of Music in Rochester, New York. Additional study beyond the Masters level was completed at Indiana University in Bloomington, Indiana. John began his teaching career in the public schools of Buffalo, as Director of Bands at Seneca Vocational High School. He later served as Orchestra Conductor for Hamburg Junior High School in Hamburg, New York. He taught on the college level at the Community Music School in Buffalo, New York, the University of Wisconsin in River Falls and the University of Wisconsin in Stevens Point, earning the academic rank of Professor. He taught in the areas of piano, theory, class piano, improvisation, and jazz ensemble conducting.

John Radd was named as Wisconsin Jazz Educator for the year 1986, by the International Association of Jazz Educators, Wisconsin Unit.

In addition to John Radd's professional teaching career he maintained a very active professional career as a pianist in the Minneapolis-St. Paul area playing with Mel Torme, Clark Terry, and Randy Becker to name a few.

John Radd served as instructor of piano, jazz theory, improvisation and Jazz Ensemble Conductor from 1978 - 1990 for the Alberta Provincial Summer Jazz Camp, first at the University of Lethbridge and later at the University of Calgary.

Words cannot adequately express the contributions John Radd made to the students, fellow colleagues and administrators throughout his 12 years of dedicated service.

BOB STROUP 1937 - 1996

IN MEMORIAM

Bob Stroup was born in Flint, Michigan. After many years of touring with the big bands of Lionel Hampton, Jimmy Dorsey, Harry James, Glenn Miller and Woody Herman (with whom he made several recordings), Bob settled in Edmonton in 1975.

Bob taught at Grant MacEwan College and led his own groups as well as appearing with the Tommy Banks Band and other jazz greats such as Dizzy Gillespie, Grady Tate, Pat LaBarbera and Bobby Shew. He is featured on many recordings both as a sideman and a leader. Most notable are his JUNO Nominee albums Entre Amis (1980) and Live At Jazz City (1980) along with Reunion (1993).

Bob taught trombone and ensemble at the Alberta Provincial Summer Jazz Camp from 1982 - 1995. He will be remembered as a great musician, teacher, colleague and friend.
