Finance Canada

The Department of Finance Canada announced that Canada's official international reserves increased by an amount equivalent to US\$1,918 million during December to US\$83,926 million. The Industrial Product Price Index decreased 0.8 per cent in November, mainly due to lower prices for energy and petroleum products.
